- The mission of the Classical Mandolin Society of America (CMSA) is to preserve and promote the playing of classical mandolin music and the tradition of mandolin orchestras. It provides scholarships to local orchestras for the purpose of developing mandolin musicianship through concerts, instruction, and preservation of historic music and the development of new compositions.
- This Convention will be attended by mandolinists, mandolists, mandocellists, and bassists from all over the United States and Canada. Typically we have 200 people in attendance.
- Two evening performances and one afternoon concert will be open to the public, culminating with the Grand En Masse Orchestra performance on Saturday, Oct. 16, in the Grand Ballroom of the Seattle Airport Marriott Hotel.
- Nationally acclaimed mandolinists **Mike Marshall** (*mikemarshall.net*), **Chris Acquavella**, with **Duo LaRé** (*chrisacquavella.com*), and the **Seasons Quartet** from Bulgaria (*qseasons.com*) are the guest artists this year. The Friday and Saturday performances are open to the public. Tickets are \$15 for each concert.
- On Thursday afternoon there will be free performances by mandolin orchestras from around the United States and Canada. This is also open to the public.
- Attendance at the evening concerts is about 300-400 people.
- Workshops on a wide variety of topics are held each day. The guest artists also provide workshops that are open to the public upon registration.
